PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



Dear members,

Building strong communities has the power to uplift the lives of everyone in Arizona. We believe in this so firmly that caring for our communities is a pillar of our mission "to truly improve the lives of our members, associates and the communities we serve."

In June, OneAZ and the OneAZ Community Foundation announced this year's Community Impact Grant recipients. This year, 50 community-building initiatives received grants of \$5,000 each, for a total of \$250,000. These grants went to organizations like Agape House of Prescott to help complete a transitional housing project for families facing homelessness; New Way Academy in Phoenix to provide educational opportunities for students with learning differences; and the Eastern Arizona Hispanic Heritage Corporation in Safford for their scholarship fund.

The Community Impact Grant program represents half of the OneAZ Community Foundation's pledge to donate \$500,000 to Arizona nonprofit organizations in 2022. This year, the Foundation launched the OneAZ Legacy Grant program, which will provide funding for more expansive projects and initiatives throughout the year as needs arise.

Improving lives in our communities also means taking intentional action to uphold our values of Diversity, Equity, Inclusion and Belonging. We recently launched our Vendor Diversity webpage that serves as the first step towards helping us build an equitable database of vendors and suppliers.

We understand that minority-owned, woman-owned, veteran-owned, LGBTQIA-owned and small businesses have traditionally faced structural obstacles when it comes to securing partners. That's why we want to do everything we can to break down those barriers. As new supplier and vendor opportunities arise, OneAZ will be able to turn to this network to build new connections and relationships that promote a more equitable and inclusive Arizona community!
